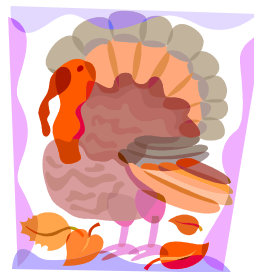


PDG Tom Feeney to Speak
